Seven Celtic Nations Flag

"I've always heard spoke of the "Seven Nations": Ireland, Scotland, Wales, Cornwall, Isle of Man, Brittany (France), Galicia (Spain). Gaelic (in either of its two branches) is spoken in six of the nations. Unfortunately, Galicia no longer has the old tongue. The music in all seven nations is remarkably similar, sharing many instruments and musical forms. The

region became modern day Galicia, which is in northwest Spain and is today considered the seventh of the original Celtic nations, along with Eire (Ireland), Kernow (Cornwall), Mannin (Isle of Mann), Breizh (Brittany), Alba (Scotland) and Cymru (Wales)."

Mackays... Living and Long Past

I received a note from Andrew Betts telling me that the Banner used to have articles about various Mackays around the world. He was involved in some of them- like the Mackay who won the Iditarod Sled Dog Race, a goat milk farmer in Vernon BC, coaches and athletes, writers and actors, etc. Some interesting- others not so much. Some who turned out to not be Mackays at all- like the boxing champion tagged as "The Real McCoy" who had just adopted a stage name. Or the seasoning company in Toledo that developed K-rations for the Army in WW II. Turns out they were Italians, but since Italy was the enemy they used a more "solid and respected" name-Mackay.

National Museum of Scotland Is Putting Its Entire Collection Online

People across the world can now view all the National Museum of Scotland has to offer without even leaving their sofas. Using Google Arts and Culture's museum view experience, which is similar to how Google's Street View works, tourists can view the 20,000 objects on display at the National Museum. The virtual display also includes 1,000 pictures of objects from the Edinburgh museum's collection.

It's the <u>first museum in Scotland that can be toured online</u>, but not the first in the world. The Taj Mahal in India and the Palace of Versailles in France have also opened up their exhibit in a similar way, giving visitors from around the world a novel opportunity to explore their interior. Google Arts and Culture hopes to continue working with institutions to make cultural and historical materials across the globe more easily accessible.

Making tours of cultural institutions available online means more people will be exposed to exhibitions that are difficult to either get to or are sold out very quickly. For example, as the real doors close on the most successful exhibition in the history of the British Library, Harry Potter: A History of Magic, virtual doors open on a version created with the library's curators for the Google Arts and Culture site.

A motion was made and carried to enhance the program and change the name of the scholarship program to Heritage Gift, which will allow us to give gifts to organizations as well as individuals. [Organizations such as Strathnaver Museum; St. Andrews Church; Culloden Battlefield Preservation; etc.] The current application will be revised.

<u>January Elections</u>: Our National Vice President and National Secretary both agreed to stay on and no one else applied to run, therefore, elections were not done this past January.

Old business:

Crest Copyright: Much discussion surrounding the clan crest has been ongoing. Most businesses will not allow us to use a symbol without signed affirmation as to the copyright. Therefore, the badge we have been using ("Manu Forti" on the side) has been copyrighted and is in process of being trademarked for our use. It has been approved by Lord Lyon King of Arms: Great Officer of State in Scotland. We've been given a letter approving the symbol and Lord Reay, Clan Mackays' Clan Chief, has also approved it. It meets all requirements of the crest by Scottish Authority and breaks no laws or rules and adheres to copyright law. This is the corporate symbol of Clan Mackay Society, USA and will be used on anything issued directly from our society. Individual members, including commissioners and tent hosts, are free to use whatever symbol/crest/badge they would like, however by using our copyrighted symbol we show clan unity and do not risk being sued for copyright infringement.

New Business:


2019 AGM needs to be hosted by the Mid-West. No one from the region on the call. Put something on the website and facebook page to get interest.
